Training of Trainers course:

impulsouth

Accelerating Just Energy Transitions

April 13th - April 23rd, 2026

The Training of Trainers (ToT) course is tailored for professionals **developing training programs** (workshops, webinars, guides), or those **developing innovation support initiatives** supporting entrepreneurs, innovators, and students through incubation, acceleration, university programs, and applied learning initiatives.

Basic information:

Duration: 2 weeks, Monday-Thursday (8 course days, plus introductory session)

Time commitment: Around 20-30 hours (10-15 hours/week)

Mode of delivery: Fully online, using a learning platform and video conferencing

Learning activities:

- Live lectures with tutors and experts, including case studies and best practices (45-60 min per day). See page 3 for full schedule.
- Interactive sessions with group discussions and exercises (45 min per module).
- Online knowledge base with important materials.
- Independent study through an online course platform, including work on developing an initiative.
- Online forum discussions for peer exchange.

Assessment and certification: Based on participation in live sessions and completion of online assignments participants will be awarded a certificate issued by United Nations University-Vice Rectorate in Europe (UNU-VIE)

Identify key knowledge / capacity gaps in your constituency & design a curriculum to address these



Determine the best format for the delivery of your initiative



Build your knowledge on key themes, concepts and tools related to gender-just energy transitions



Undertake further research, through a curated knowledge base



Network, share with and learn from your peers



Have the opportunity to submit your proposal for funding at the end of the course

Course contents:

The ToT course consists of **four foundational** and **four thematic modules**. Completion of all four thematic modules is encouraged but not compulsory; participants must complete **at least three thematic modules** in order to be eligible for a certificate.

We invite you to apply for the ToT course if you meet the following criteria.

- Member of an organization that is a part of the ImpulSouth *Global South Just Energy Transition* Community of Practice, or is willing to join. Please join the Community of Practice [here](#).
- Based and professionally active in one or more of the nine partner countries (**Africa: Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, Madagascar, Uganda, Zambia; LAC: Bolivia, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Guatemala**)
- The capacity and institutional support to commit the time required to complete the course.
- Member of an organisation with a **capacity building or innovation support mandate**.
- Mid-career level professional with prior experience of capacity building/a capacity building role, and **prior knowledge of or demonstrated interest in gender-just energy transitions**.
- The capacity and institutional support to design, fundraise for, and implement a **capacity-building or innovation support initiative** based on the learnings of the course.
- Have a capacity-building or innovation support initiative concept that includes the basic idea of a target audience and their possible learning needs.
- **High proficiency in English** (some course content will support additional languages, however course inputs and final proposal will be expected to be in English).
- Have access to **reliable internet connection**.

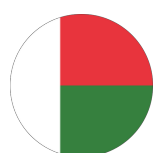
